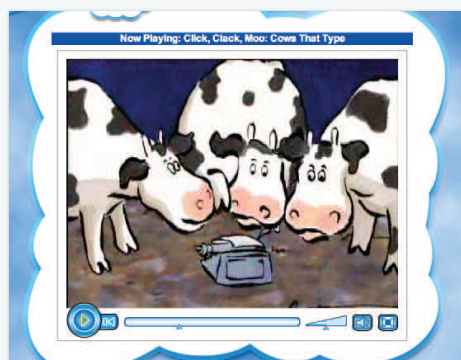

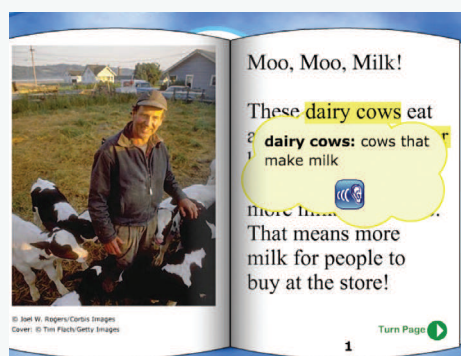

Watch the Story!

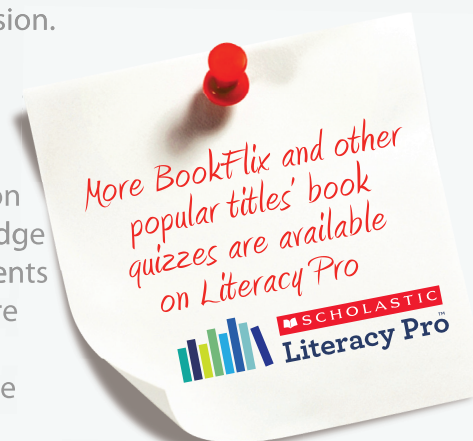
Video adaptations of classic children's books will motivate all readers including beginning, reluctant and ELT students – and enrich their interactions with books.
